Psalm 121

- ¹I lift up my eyes to the hills. From where does my help come?
- ²My help comes from the LORD, who made heaven and earth.
- ³ He will not let your foot be moved; he who keeps you will not slumber.
- ⁴Behold, he who keeps Israel will neither slumber nor sleep.
- ⁵The LORD is your keeper; the LORD is your shade on your right hand.
- ⁶The sun shall not strike you by day, nor the moon by night.
- ⁷The LORD will keep you from all evil; he will keep your life.
- 8 The LORD will keep your going out and your coming in from this time forth and forevermore.
